Project Description:

The Government of Japan generously provided support for the newly established Gaza International Airport. The project consists of 2 parts. The first part was to design and construct the South Wing terminal building and power station at Gaza International Airport. The second one was training course for Civil Aviation Authority personnel and national expatriates and demilitarization training. The training for the civil aviation authority took place in Jordan, Morocco and it was co-financed by the Government of Japan and the Palestinian National Authority/ Civil Aviation.

Objectives:

1. To improve and ease traveling conditions through developing the airport facilities, and providing training for the Aviation Authority personnel and national expatriates'.
2. To create job opportunities to unemployed workers through carrying out construction activities.
3. To establish a symbol of state authority and Autonomy for the Palestinian people.

Palestinian international airport with total area space 2700 m2 is available for the use of Palestinian passengers.

Outputs:

- Aviation Authority personnel and national expatriates' are provided with a high level of training, and qualified to run the airport operations.
- The South Wing Terminal is constructed, equipped and furnished for effective and easy movement for the Palestinians.
