The project is designed to bring pro-poor and participatory perspectives to national development policies and planning through establishing model participatory national and district level consultative mechanisms

Objectives:

1. Capacity for the MOP to deliver a poverty-focused and broadly owned Medium Term Development Plan strengthened
2. Institutional arrangements at district level for partnership and advocacy for poverty reduction are established and capacity strengthened
3. At national level, sector planning units/departments are formally linked to MOP and PPP is able to influence key national policies and programmes
4. NCPE expanded and effective
5. Capacity for participatory planning for poverty reduction strengthened in the West Bank and Gaza Strip
