**Project Description:**

The project undertakes to provide a monitoring tool to gauge efficiency and impact of emergency and developmental assistance in the Palestinian territories through bi-annual perceptions surveys. The perceptions surveys are designed to assess this impact on a sectoral and cross-sectoral basis. The project is designed to provide national and international stakeholders with regular data analysis from the surveys as well as a policy oriented recommendations deriving from analytical work on survey data.

**Objectives:**

1. to provide qualitative and quantitative analysis and data on human development in the oPt;
2. to contribute to the planning of national development and assistance programme by the Palestinian National Authority, donors, civil societies and other stakeholders; and
3. to supply independent monitoring tools available to a wide range of stakeholders.
