**Project Description:**

Many needs can be addressed through this present technical assistance package: formulation of strategies; assessment of capacities; reform of governance rules and procedures, including those for the market and the most vulnerable; review and restructuring of functions and networks; improvement of systems, especially those concerned with planning, management, information and new technologies, budgeting and expenditures, statistics, reporting and accountability; reform of wage and incentive structures; private-public partnerships; and decentralization. The central issues of sustainability - ownership, fiscal discipline, incentives, political support and external aid - would also be addressed. Gender concerns and Millennium Development Goals (MDG's) should be built into all of the foreseen tasks.

**Objectives:**

1. Strengthened PA and other beneficiary infrastructure, institution management and administration capacity; strengthened democratic governance institutions; strengthened rule of law interventions; strengthened communication and access to information procedures; enhanced participatory development management processes.
2. Increased effectiveness of governance institutions in managing public policy issues, empowered rule of law, enhanced decentralization, inter-ministerial or central/local; improved communications and access to information
3. PA interactions, information technology and communications as enabler development tools, bilateral negotiations, and other PA/civil society transparency processes; increased empowerment of civil society institutions working on reform issues.
