Project Description:

With the recent adoption of the 2004-2005 Reform Plan outlining the strategy of the Palestinian Authority (PA), there have been promises made to introduce significant improvements into the Palestinian public sector. As a leading partner in the on going efforts under Public Administration Reform (PAR), the aim of the UNDP is to keep providing technical assistance support to the line ministries presently engaged in the Palestinian Authority reform programme along the lines of the Medium Term Development Plan 2005-2007 as presented by the Ministry of Planning.
