### **Project Description:**

This programme include construction and development of water infrastructure projects in six localities in the West Bank including; 1) installation of 1200 house water connections in Ain Qinya; 2) construction of 300CM ground water reservoir, a booster station and 200 CM balance tank in Qufr Qalil; installation of 1600 house water connections in Yatta; construction of 200CM elevated Water Reservoir in Rantis; Rehabilitation of the 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of water network in Shuqba including installation of 500 CM water connections and finally the construction of the 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of Water Network including House water connections in Baqa Sharqiya town.

### **Objectives:**

1. to create job opportunities through water infrastructure development
2. to improve water supply services to the residents of 6 towns in the West Bank;

### **Locations:**

Ain Qinya; Rantis, Shuqba (Ramallah District) Kufr Qalil (Nablus district), Yatta,(Hebron District) , and Baqa Sharqiya (Tulkarem District);

### **Products (as of end – May 2006):**

95% of Ein Qinia and Qufr Qalil projects will be completed

### **Outputs:**

- The availability of water per capita, for residents of the targeted area is improved;
- The quality of water supply is improved ( Municipal water supply is chlorinated and monitored)
- The overall well being of the beneficiaries is improved and particularly their health status.
- The potential development of the whole area including other sectors such as agriculture and industry, will be improved substantially.
