Project Description:

This project aims to improve capacities of the women-owned household economic activities through provision of technical and financial assistance and create employment.

Objectives:

The ultimate objective of the project is to secure incomes of poor families in West Bank and Gaza, and create job opportunities for those who have lost jobs in the Israeli market in order to meet urgent economic needs in the time of special economic hardship among Palestinian households under the prevailing political crisis.

Locations:

West Bank and Gaza

Products:

- Training
- Micro credit
- Income generation

Outputs:

- 100 women were trained before applying for a grant in Nablus
- 88 women received machines, tools and equipment whose values ranged from \$500 to \$1,000 in Nablus
- 28 women received loans in Al-Burjim Hebron
- 30 women were trained for 45 hour training on raising sheep and given sheep in Al-Sawarhah in Gaza
- 9 women received loans in Ramallah
