Project Description:

The project aims at providing technical and infrastructural support to the only governmental agency caring for the homeless and disabled elderly people, located in Jericho. Works will include the leveling and reconstruction of the old site, originally built in 1995 in Jericho over a 23-dunum plot of land, to service the needs of at least 80 old people (currently 30 old persons (6 females and 24 males) are using the facilities), and 18 staff members. The infrastructural work will cover approximately 340 square meters of construction and 8,500 square meters of landscaping (parking, sheds, pathways, and gardens), as well as finishing of the uncompleted building that was intended to house the new kitchen and storage facilities. The infrastructural component will be complemented with the capacity building exercise for the Ministry of Social Affairs whereby the internal rules and regulations, as well as the by-laws will be established, followed by fine-tuning the terms of reference for the staff, and conducting needed capacity building for their work to become more effective and efficient staff members. Total number of expected workdays generated is 14,331, based on the average of €11.475 per day.
