Project Description:

The project aims at constructing of 200 residential units and corresponding services (water networks, sewage network, electrical network and roads).

122 housing units will be constructed in Tal El Sultan Neighborhood in Rafah, and 78 units in Khan Younis .

Objectives:

1. To accommodate 200 non-refugee families whose houses were destructed through Al Aqsa Intifada
2. To reduce unemployment through generating 75,000 workdays for unemployed workers in the targeted area.

Locations:

- Rafah- Tal El Sultan Neighborhood (78 units)
- Khan Younis-Western Area (122 units)

Products (as of end – May 2006):

- The designs for the housing units in both Rafah and Khan Younis were completed.

Outputs:

- 200 residential unites are to be constructed for families who lost their houses in Rafah and Khan Younis.
- Around 75,000 workdays are to be generated.
