**Project Description:**

The project aims at assisting the communities living in dire socio-economical situations resulting from the Israeli-imposed Closures and mobility limitations in the Governorates mostly hit and affected in the West Bank. The project aims at improving social and municipal services in impoverished Palestinian communities through the rehabilitation and reconstruction of essential physical infrastructure, particularly water and sewage networks, roads, electricity networks, as well as small scale municipal works. Additionally, the project targets a number of sectors with potential to absorb high numbers of laborers, prioritizing the interventions in accordance with the following considerations: the sustainability of the activities selected; existing constraints presently impeding the work and production cycle in many sectors; various available implementation mechanisms to ensure the highest absorption capacity, and distribution of works to reach the most hardly hit areas during the last period. The project is totally in line with the Palestinian Authority's emergency programmes developed to respond to the recent crisis. The implementation will be fully supervised by UNDP in partnership with capable Palestinian institutions. It will create approximately 36,800 person workdays adopting a minimum wage of US\$ 15/day.

**Objectives:**

1. Rehabilitation of water supply and distribution systems
2. Developing and maintenance of sewage collection and storm water drainage systems
3. Asphalt paving and rehabilitation of access and internal roads
4. Rehabilitation and extension of electricity networks.
5. Conducting small-scale infrastructure works in the municipal and educational sectors.

**Outputs:**

- Water supply and distribution systems has been rehabilitated in 9 towns and villages, leading to improved living and health condition, and the building of two 500-cubic meter water reservoirs.
- Sewage collection and drainage systems has been developed, rehabilitated, or extended in one locality, which will improve the health conditions and reduce the risk of diseases resulting from bad sanitary conditions.
- Access and internal roads will have been rehabilitated and provided with asphalt pavement in 20 towns/villages, which will facilitate movement and increase safety within the villages/towns, with no less than 32.5 kilometres of roads.
- Electricity supply networks will have been rehabilitated or extended in 2 communities, resulting in improved living conditions.
- Basic community services will be provided to two localities through the establishment of local community services centers.
- Health services will be provided to two localities through the establishment of medical services facilities.
- On the educational level, extension and additional classrooms will be extended to 4 localities.
