Project Description:

The program includes employment creation through the provision of educational infrastructure and youth service programs in three clusters of rural areas including eleven villages in the northern districts of Jenin and Qalqilya, with a total population of approximately 23,000.

Objectives:

1. To create immediate job opportunities through a set of labor-intensive infrastructure development interventions that will generate approximately 30,857 skilled and unskilled person workdays.
2. To increase the capacity of and improve the conditions of educational facilities through the construction or rehabilitation of schools and providing access of youth to these facilities.
3. To strengthen community interactions by promoting the schools as a center for community and youth development

Locations:

The villages of of Raba, Mutela, Al Moghayer, Rumana, Araqa and Anin in Jenin Governorate, and the villages of Kufer Thilth, Sinirya, Habla, Al Funduq and Isla in Qalqilya Governorate in the West Bank

Outputs:

- Construction of five new schools to include 50 new educational rooms, sanitary units and play grounds in the villages of Raba, Al Moghayer, Rumana, Araqa and Anin in Jenin Governorate
- Expansion Rehabilitation of six schools to include addition of 35 new educational rooms, rehabilitation of 25 educational rooms, sanitary units and play grounds in the villages of Kufer Thilth, Sinirya, Habla, Al Funduq and Isla in Qalqilya Governorate and in the village of Al Mutela in Jenin Governorate.
- Conducting Youth Activity Programmes in the Villages of Raba and Rumana in Jenin Governorate and in the village of Kufer Thilth in Qalqilya Governorate.
