Project Description:

This project is a continuing effort to revive the old city of Hebron through the rehabilitation the existing homes and infrastructure in the old city, encourage Palestinians to move back into the rehabilitated homes through low rents, and thus encourage the return of economic activity.

Objectives:

1. To rehabilitate and restore homes and infrastructure in the Old City
2. To create short term employment opportunities through labor intensive methods.
3. To re-inhabit the homes and restore a semblance of economic activity in the area.

Locations:

Project is located in the Old City of Hebron, in the West Bank.

Products (as of end – May 2006):

- 52 Apartments were rehabilitated and restored.
- Another 14 Apartments are currently being restored.
- 240 persons have moved into the buildings
- Approximately 31,000 workdays were generated

Outputs:

The programme provided improvement to the quality of living conditions of those residing in the old city of Hebron and helped in economic revitalization of the old city Market.
