Psychological Relief for Traumatized Palestinian Children and Emergency Employment Generation through the Establishment of Recreation Facilities for Families and Children

Objectives:

1. Relieving the psychological effects on Palestinian Children and their families inflicted on them due to the prevailing political situation.
2. Psychological Intervention
3. Provide several deprived and vulnerable localities of the West Bank and Gaza appropriate and safe areas for recreation and conduction of cultural and sports activities, namely; a number of playgrounds and parks.
4. Utilizing labor intensive techniques generate hundreds of employment opportunities for unemployed workers from the West Bank and the Gaza Strip.

Products (as of end – May 2006):

13 NGOs participated in psychological interventions and recreational activities, 29 playgrounds were constructed, Social workers and school teachers were trained. 40 women in Nablus and Jenin areas were trained how to face difficulties.
