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**Project Description:**

This project will encompass the construction of a General Secondary Hospital in the Qalqilia District. Since the outbreak of hostilities in September 2000, the Qalqilia District has been isolated and encircled its inhabitants over 95,000 residents, especially with the Separation Wall that further inhibits movement. Despite the fact that there is an UNRWA hospital in Qalqilia yet it has a capacity of 63 beds, which falls short of offering the needed health services to the encircled population of Qalqilia. The project will consist of the construction of a 4,000 square meter 50 bed facility which will encompass basic services such as a maternity and internal medicine wards, laboratory, pharmacy, Intensive Care Unit (ICU), surgical theater, pediatric department, x-ray department, cafeteria, and emergency clinic.

**Objectives:**

1. Construction of the basement, ground, first and second floors encompassing roughly 4,000 square meters, with a bed capacity of 50.
2. The basement floor will house:
  - Machinery Room for hospital boilers, medical gases, electrical and air conditioning rooms.
  - Laundry, stores, morgue, and maintenance department.
  - Water cistern.
  - Kitchen and Dining room.
3. The ground floor will comprise of the following units:
  - Emergency and Outpatient units.
  - Reception and Public Area.
  - Laboratory and radiology department.
  - Kidney Ward.

4. The first floor will comprise of the following units:

- Male and Female Wards.
- Pediatric Department.
- Intensive Care Unit (ICU).
- Administration Ward.

5. The second floor will comprise of the following units:

- Three operating theatres.
- Recovery rooms.
- Delivery rooms and post-delivery ward.
- Sterilization department.

**Locations:**

Qalqilia City.

**Products (as of end – May 2006):**

Phase one which involves the skeleton works is nearing completion. Handover is planned by 20 June 2006.

**Outputs:**

The longer-term development objective of this project is the improvement of the health of the population of Qalqilia District by providing access of residents of the region to a larger, fully equipped and modernized district hospital, linked closely, on the one hand, with the Primary Health Care network of the district, and on the other, to the UNRWA and Other Hospitals as tertiary referral facilities for more complicated care and treatment.
