Project Description:

The project aims at supporting Rafah families who lost their houses and belongings due to Israeli incursions in Rafah city. The project's main component is to support these families by providing them with essential house equipments and supplies in order to help them in resettling.

Objectives:

1. Provide essential commodities and supplies for all the families whose homes were destroyed.
2. Improve the situation for the poor people in Rafah after their homes demolished
3. Accommodate the immediate needs for the people through procurement of their needs from the different suppliers

Locations:

Rafah Area –Rafah Camps

Products (as of end – May 2006):

- A number of poor families receive equipments from Rafah Governorate according to their needs and the size of the family. (washing machines, gas burners, iron, stoves, refrigerators, furniture)

Outputs:

- reducing the suffering of the number of Palestinians who are in need for this essential equipment that were destroyed when their homes were demolished
- Improving the overall living conditions, and assists in alleviating poverty for those mostly affected and vulnerable segment of the target area.
