Project Description:

This is the second phase of the TRAC project which aims at continuing the funding of emergency support in the field of institutional strengthening, organizational development and capacity building for public and organizations in the Gaza strip. It provides technical assistance to governmental organizations and NGO's, covers the salaries of local experts, funds procurement of essential tools and equipment, organizes training programs ...etc. The project is also contributes in reducing the negative impact of the Intifada on the deprived communities and localities through providing urgent relief assistance to poor families and community organizations working in these areas.

Objectives:

1. To increase the capacity of selected public and non-governmental organizations as well as to improve the level of services delivered by these organizations in the Gaza Strip.
2. To mitigate the negative impact of the current severe political, economic and social circumstances of the Intifada on the deprived communities and localities.
