**Project Description:**

The main goal of TASHGHIL is to alleviate poverty, generate employment and improve access to basic social services in impoverished Palestinian communities through labor-intensive social development, while providing long-term impact through human development programs that will benefit children, youth, women and other marginalized segments of the population. TASHGHIL targets two main intervention areas (TIA's) the Northern West Bank, and Gaza.

**Objectives:**

1. To provide immediate job opportunities through a set of labor-intensive interventions that will generate approximately 219,893 skilled and unskilled person workdays.
2. To improve access to basic social services in the TIAs through the construction or improvement of schools, roads, and multipurpose municipal/ community centers.
3. To enhance economic growth and create sustainable jobs.
4. To empower youth and women through training, cultural, educational and vocational activities.

**Locations:**

- West Bank: Jenin (9 locations), Tulkarem (13 locations) and Qalqilia (10 locations) districts,
- Gaza Strip: Gaza City and the northern areas of Jabalia, Beit Lahia and Beit Hanoun

- For the West Bank Municipal and Educational sector, the accumulated number of working days generated as a result of the implementation is 64910 workdays. The Number of workdays generated as a result of the design and tender preparation is 2,398.
- For the West Bank Cultural Heritage sector, the accumulated number of working days generated as a result of the implementation is 49,967 workdays. The Number of workdays generated as a result of the design and tender preparation is 10,576.
- For the Gaza components, the total accumulative workdays generated since the beginning of the project was 158,533.
- All Gaza Agricultural Project activities were completed by the end of March 2004. Follow up on implemented projects has taken place immediately after the Israeli incursion in Beit Hanoun area and damages resulting from this incursion have been reported directly to USAID. Nearly 80% (5 kilometers out of 6.3km) of the rehabilitated agricultural roads have been totally damaged. 34% of the rehabilitated citrus and olive orchards (585 dunums out of 1,728), 18 out of the rehabilitated 78 greenhouses, 50 out of the 318 dunums of the replanted damaged agricultural land and 50 out of the 288 upgraded irrigation networks have been totally bulldozed as a result of this incursion. This means that Beit Hanoun area has lost the value of nearly 34% of implemented agricultural projects.
