Senior Oracle/ Java Developer

General Responsibilities:

Reporting to the Property Tax Reform Project Manager, the senior Oracle/ Java developer is expected to analyze user requirements, develop/write, debug, bug fixing PL/SQL stored procedures and functions, packages and libraries, reports development using Report 6i and higher, SQL script development. The Oracle Developer will be responsible for:

1. Working with respective stakeholders to enhance and/ or adapt the Property tax software to the local needs and in coordination with respective stakeholders.
2. Managing meetings, consultations, training and workshops on the IT component as needed.

Qualifications

The successful candidate must be flexible in his/her approach, and capable of making a cooperative contribution to the work of the project team. In addition, the candidate must:

- Have a Bachelor's degree in computer science
- 5+ years of experience in Oracle development technologies such as PLSQL, SQL Plus, Developer 6i and higher including Forms 6i and higher, reports 6i and higher.
- DBA skills is a must
- Have Java Development experience
- Expertise in writing, debugging, bug fixing PL/SQL stored procedures and functions, packages and libraries, reports development using Report 6i and higher, SQL script development.
- Strong expertise on Windows/UNIX platform.
- Deep understanding of intricacies related to Oracle development, such as how to write an efficient program v/s just a program that meets the requirement.
- Expert level knowledge of Oracle applications technical architecture across all modules.
- Oracle applications PLL, type of concurrent programs and methods of developing and registering them. Moderate to Advance knowledge of Oracle applications 10g, 9i development and business flow and ability to carry out technical upgrade for custom code during system wide upgrade.
- Must have experience working on complex web-based Oracle Forms and Reports; analyze user requirements; excellent communication skills is a must.
