The project will contribute to gender equality in the oPt through in-house capacity development

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

In partnership with Sharek Youth Forum, the project will achieve that children and youth have access to secured places for social and educational activities by establish 36 homework centers in the West Bank and Gaza with computers, furniture and recreational and educational materials. The project will also provide training to university students as youth volunteers/ mentors so that they can teach and play with younger children. By doing so, the project will contribute to the improvement of educational and social skills of young male and female. The homework centers are places for youth and children, both male and female, to study homework, learn social skills and enrich their extra curriculum activities.
