Improvement of Solid Waste Management in the Occupied Palestinian Territory

PROJECT AIM (OVERALL OBJECTIVE)

The project aims to improve solid waste management services of four Joint Councils Services for Planning and development (JCspd) in four Governorates in Palestine, including Jericho & the Jordan River Rift Valley, Bethlehem, Salfet and Tulkarem.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The main project activity is to procure solid waste management equipment (Containers, compactor and dump trucks, loaders, and compaction units) including, collection, transfer and land filling. The project will improve the overall management and services delivered to the 491,168 residents of these Governorates and improve their standards of living accordingly.


OBJECTIVES

- Protection of the natural resources.
- Improvement of the living standards for about 491,168 residents in the West Bank.
- Improvement of health conditions.
- Improvement of environmental conditions.

PROGRESS UP TO DATE

- Equipment specifications, tender documents, tendering process, evaluation of bids of the three contracts (containers, heavy machinery, backhoe loaders).
- Award of the contract for the containers to a local company to deliver 2,085 units 1.1m3 Containers, spare parts for the 1.1 m3 Containers and 10 units 8m3 Containers.
- In the process to award the heavy machinery component of the project.

Geographic Location

- The capacities within the 4 JCSPD with regard to solid waste management are enhanced;

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- Public health status in the targeted areas is improved;
