Emergency Rehabilitation of Damaged Municipal Infrastructure in Beit Hanoun (CERF)

THEMATIC AREA

Environment and Energy

PROJECT AIM (OVERALL OBJECTIVE)

The project will provide easier access to health and educational facilities at the town of Beit Hanoun and reduce potential health problems through the repair of wastewater and storm water lines.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project activities will include the rehabilitation of destroyed stretches of 28 roads, complete repair of the damaged water, waste water and storm water lines, and rehabilitation of affected electrical installations, in addition to repairing the boundary walls of the buildings adjacent to the targeted roads. The project activities will also include the rehabilitation and repair of 8 buildings for the local community and public organizations such as women, youth and children centers.

OBJECTIVES

The key objective of the programme is to improve the living conditions of some 35,000 inhabitants of the town of Beit Hanoun through the following activities:

- Rehabilitation of the destroyed roads including tiling/asphalting, water, waste water and storm water lines, and
- Rehabilitation of damaged community facilities and buildings.

IMPACT STATEMENT

The project contributed to providing easier access to health and educational facilities at the town, improved the level of water availability, and reduced potential health problems through the repair of wastewater and storm water lines. In addition, the project enabled local organizations to deliver their services to the beneficiaries such as women, children and youth. These impacts will positively affect the humanitarian activities and the overall living conditions in the targeted town of Beit Hanoun.

PROGRESS UP TO DATE

The cumulative progress of all the packages is 26.11%. This relatively low level of progress, as more than 80% of the contract duration has passed, is due to the scarcity of the materials in the local market due to closure of crossing points.

CONSTRAINTS (if any)

- The contract with Abu Zeyada Company which included Packages Number (1, 2, 3, 4, 6 & 7) with amount of US\$2,820,998 was suspended due to the current situation in Gaza where all the border points have been closed. The suspension took place from 25th of July for an initial period of two months.
- The contract with amount of \$119,214.6 for package number 5 which was signed with Gaza Electricity Distribution Cooperation Ltd. (GEDECO) is ongoing.
